Day 1. Thur 17 Jul: Brisbane - Stanthorpe

Lunch & Dinner

Today we board our coach with our travelling friends and commence our holiday to **Stanthorpe**, travelling via Maryvale and making our way to the **Warwick and District Historical Society Museum Complex Heritage** buildings, viewing their display of tea pots, tea sets and tea cosies, working vintage machinery, horse sulky's and more. We then continue onto the heritage listed **Glengallan Homestead** for lunch and a guided tour of this historic sandstone mansion which dates back more than 150 years. We arrive into Stanthorpe and stop by **Kent Saddlery**, established in 1988 when owners Lyle & Helen decided to make a big change from vegetable farming to saddlery. We gain an insight into the various techniques and processes that go into making the leather goods! It's then a short drive to check into our motel for the next 3 nights. After a freshen up we enjoy dinner in the motel restaurant.

Day 2: Fri 18 Jul: Stanthorpe

Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast this morning, we set off for a day of touring the **Granite Belt Region**. Our first stop is the **Jamworks**, which takes pride in selecting only the freshest and best quality ingredients for their preserves. We can try a wide selection of jams and chutneys at the tasting bar while chatting with the staff, who are always happy to assist and answer any of our questions. We then finish our visit with a **Devonshire Tea** before heading to the **Symphony Hill Vineyard** for a tour through the state-of-the-art facilities and enjoy wine tastings. Take in the aromas of the candle lit barrel room and wander through the contemporary tasting room, complete with chandelier and 1960s original whistler lounge which has been reupholstered bright red. Symphony Hill embodies the cutting edge, neo-vino wine movement that dares to take Australian wines in fresh and exciting directions. We then make our way back towards Stanthorpe with a stop enroute at **Storm King Dam**. Our next stop is at the **Artworks Gallery**, home to a permanent collection of almost 900 pieces. We enjoy free time in the main street with time to purchase lunch. It's then a short drive to our next destination, which is the **Truffle Discovery Centre** for a guided tour of the trees and a chance to taste the rare and highly valuable French Black Perigold Truffles! Afterwards we head back to our motel to enjoy some time at leisure before dinner at the award-winning **Varias Restaurant**.

Day 3. Sat 19 Jul: Stanthorpe

Breakfast & Lunch & Dinner

The Granite Belt is situated on the northern edge of the New England Tableland, right on the border between Queensland and New South Wales. We enjoy breakfast this morning before we depart on a full day of touring and sampling some of the region's amazing produce. First stop is the **Granite Belt Christmas Farm** which is nestled in the heart of the Granite Belt wine region. Our visit includes a farm tour, along with a cup of their famous Belgian hot chocolate before enjoying some time taking in the magic of Christmas through the doors of the Mistletoe Store and browse the spectacular range of Christmas decorations and gifts. Taste, indulge and enjoy 'Mrs. Claus' festive hand-crafted sweet treats and gourmet products. After browsing the shop, we head to the **Blue Pot Pantry** for lunch in a quaint country location overlooking Stanthorpe. After lunch we visit Queensland's oldest family-owned and operated winery, the **Ballandean Estate** – established in 1932. We enjoy the opportunity to learn about the cool climate, high altitude international award-winning wines, and of course a chance to taste them too! We then head back to the motel to relax before our final dinner in the motel restaurant.

We now commence the final leg of our time away, heading back to Brisbane after a wonderful time away with Donald Simpson Centre and Trade Travel in the beautiful Granite Belt region.
