### **Day 1. Sun 15 Aug: Brisbane to Lithgow**

**Lunch & Dinner**

We depart Brisbane this morning on our flight to Sydney before travelling west into the Blue Mountains. Our first stop is the Norman Lindsay Gallery at Springwood, where we explore the artist's former home, studio and heritage gardens. After lunch, we continue via Blackheath to Govetts Leap Lookout for sweeping views across the Grose Valley, we then visit the Blue Mountains Heritage Centre before checking into Lithgow Workers Club Motel.

### **Day 2. Mon 16 Aug: Lithgow & Zig Zag Railway**

**Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

After breakfast, we visit Blast Furnace Park to discover Lithgow's significant industrial heritage. We then travel to Clarence Station to board the famous Zig Zag Heritage Railway, enjoying a nostalgic steam train journey through tunnels and across historic viaducts. Following lunch at a local café, we tour Eskbank House and Garden, one of the valley's oldest residences, rich in mining history. Late afternoon we return to our motel to relax before gathering for dinner.

### **Day 3. Tue 17 Aug: Katoomba & Leura**

**Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

Today we explore the heart of the Blue Mountains. Travelling along Cliff Drive, we stop at Echo Point to admire the iconic Three Sisters. At Scenic World, our Scenic Pass includes the Skyway, Cableway, Rail and Walkway through ancient rainforest. Afterward, we enjoy time and lunch in charming Leura Village, browsing galleries and specialty shops. Our final stop is Everglades House and Gardens, where terraced landscapes overlook dramatic escarpments. We return to Lithgow for dinner.

## Day 4. Wed 18 Aug: Portland & Mt Wilson Gardens

Breakfast & Dinner

This morning we tour Mt Piper Power Station, gaining insight into modern energy production. In Portland, a local guide introduces The Foundations precinct and impressive silo murals honouring former cement workers. After lunch (own expense) back in Lithgow, we travel to Mt Wilson to visit the elegant Bebeah Garden and beautiful Windyridge Garden, where we enjoy tea and biscuits. Returning to Lithgow, we freshen up before sharing a special farewell dinner together.

Breakfast & Lunch

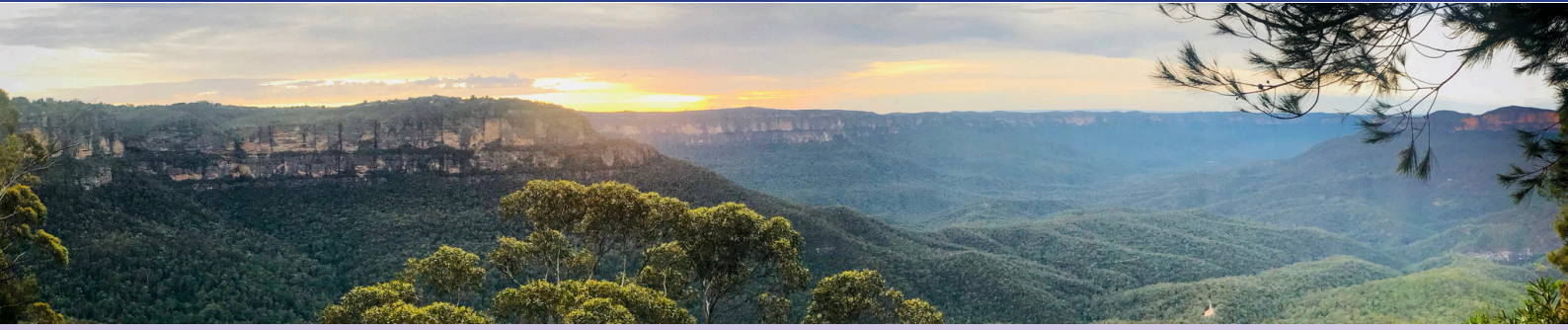
