Day 1. Mon 06 Jul: Brisbane - Hervey Bay

Lunch & Dinner

This morning, we board our coach and make our way to the beautiful Sunshine Coast and the surrounding picturesque hinterland. We ascend the Blackall Range via Landsborough passing the Mary Cairncross Park and then north to **Montville**, a beautiful village full of charm with a myriad of art galleries, antique stores, fashion houses, gift and antique shops. While here we will enjoy morning tea before continuing to **Mapleton** where the village flanks the National Park and takes in the views from Noosa to Maroochydore. We continue north to **Gympie**, a historic town that has been heralded as the "town that saved Queensland". The discovery of gold by James Nash back in 1867 on the site of the Gympie Town Hall, attracted over 15,000 men to come and dig for their fortune and the Gold Rush began. We stop and enjoy a stroll around one of the towns' most beautiful parks or take a walk along historical Mary Street with its traditional shop fronts. We then visit Gympie's **Woodworks Museum**, enjoying a **light lunch then a Museum Tour**, which includes the Sawmill and Blacksmith demonstrations. We continue our drive north to **Hervey Bay** and check into our accommodation with time to freshen up before dinner in the resort restaurant.

Day 2. Tues 07 Jul: Hervey Bay

Breakfast & Sunset Canapés

We enjoy breakfast this morning, then have the morning at leisure to take a stroll along the esplanade, visit the pier or take in a spot of shopping! Enjoy a light lunch at one of the many local eateries (own expense). Early afternoon we board our coach and make our way to **Whalesong Sunset Cruises** and board our vessel to begin our **afternoon cruise** along the pristine waters of the Sandy Bay Straits which lie between **Fraser Island** and the Fraser Coast. We enjoy a wonderful **selection of delicious canapés.** Afterwards we make our way back to our accommodation after an enjoyable evening.

Overnight: Ramada Resort Hervey Bay

Day 3. Wed 08 Jul: Fraser Island

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast, we transfer to River Heads to begin our **Fraser Island adventure**. Boarding our **Fraser Explorer 4WD tour**, we journey across this World Heritage-listed Island—home to ancient rainforests, freshwater creeks, and towering dunes. We stroll the **Wanggoolba Creek boardwalk**, home to King Ferns and lush Eucalyptus. At **Seventy-Five Mile Beach**, we see the rusting hull of the iconic **Maheno shipwreck**, washed ashore in 1935. Marvel at massive mobile sand dunes, shaped by strong south-easterly winds, and admire the vibrantly layered Coloured Sands near Eli Creek, boasting over 70 hues. A delicious **buffet lunch** is served at **Eurong Beach Resort**, providing a chance to relax and refuel. After a day filled with natural wonders and rich stories, we return to Hervey Bay in the afternoon with time to unwind before dinner at the resort's restaurant.

Day 4. Thurs 09 Jul: Childers - Bundaberg - Town of 1770

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast we pack our bags and make our way via **Childers** to **Bundaberg**, the southern-most access point to the The Great Barrier Reef. Our first stop is **Childers**, where we stop at a local cafe **Kape Centro**, and enjoy morning tea. We then visit the **Childers Pharmaceutical Museum**, a heritage listed former pharmacy overflowing with captivating pharmaceutical displays and early medicines from the last century. Next, we visit the **Palace Backpacker Memorial** before we board our coach and depart for Bundaberg. This district is well known for its sugar, beef, tomatoes, avocados, and melons.

Day 4 Cont...We will visit Hinkler's Hall of Aviation that celebrates Bert Hinkler, and the wonders of innovation, spirit and adventure displayed through multi-media exhibits, a flight simulator, a theatrette, aircraft and the museum of Hinkler House, a true aviation experience! Enjoy lunch at Cafe 1928, before continuing north to Agnes Waters and the Town of 1770. Lieutenant James Cook made the first landfall by a European here, on what was to become the Discovery Coast and the birthplace of Queensland. We now check into our accommodation and enjoy dinner in the resort restaurant.

Overnight: Lagoons 1770 Resort

Day 5. Fri 10 Jul: Town of 1770

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today after breakfast, we meet our crew and board the amphibious duck 'The Larc' for a journey across tidal creeks in the Eurimbula National Park to historic Bustard Head Light Station, where one of the most spectacular panoramic views in Australia awaits us. We hear the tales of tragedy and triumph of the early settlers and lighthouse keepers who struggled to tame this remote wilderness and the mysteries and secrets of Middle Island. We encounter some of the prolific wildlife that inhabits the area, see kangaroos resting lazily in the shade of casuarinas, watch the dolphins and turtles play in the bay and the sea eagles and pelicans flying overhead. Our unique experience includes morning tea, a picnic lunch with billy tea and time for a stroll along the beach, as well as having the chance to experience the thrill of sand boarding down the towering dunes on Middle Island! Late afternoon we make our way back to our accommodation and enjoy dinner in the resort restaurant.

Overnight: Lagoons 1770 Resort

Day 6. Sat 11 Jul: 1770 - Maryborough

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

An early start for breakfast today, as we make our way south with a comfort stop along the way, we will stop for morning tea at a local cafe. We now continue south where our next stop is **Maryborough**. Enjoy lunch at the **Carriers Arms Hotel** and then **The Story Bank** awaits. Discover the magic of Mary Poppins at the birthplace of her author, P.L. Travers. Once upon a time a baby girl was born in the upstairs bedroom at the Australian Joint Stock Bank on the corner of Kent and Richmond Streets in Maryborough, Queensland. Her name was Helen Lyndon Goff, but she became known to the world as P.L. Travers, author of the Mary Poppins stories. Whilst in the Portside Precinct, we will visit the **Military Museum** and the Bond Store, where we experience a combination of storytelling and yarns about the **Bond Store** and its role in the thirsty days of the early settlement, whilst incorporating a **tantalizing tasting experience** of ports and liqueurs from Moffatdale Ridge. Look around the Bond Store and take in the displays which use sound and video to engage visitors in the region's history and highlight the original use of the building. It's now time to check-in to our accommodation for a rest before dinner in the motel restaurant.

Overnight: McNevins Motel Maryborough

Day 7. Sun 12 Jul: Maryborough - Brisbane

Breakfast & Lunch

It's the final day of our adventure and after breakfast, we pack our bags and make our way home, with our first stop being at **Puzzles on Yabba in Imbil**, which has on display, the third largest jig-saw puzzle - an incredible 33,000 pieces. We enjoy morning tea (from coach) at a local park then make our way to Pomona and visit **The Majestic Theatre**, located in the heart of the Noosa Hinterland in the small historic town of **Pomona**. The Majestic Theatre is a not for profit, small community run theatre and cinema that has been in operation for 96 years as both a community hall and a silent film theatre. Relax and enjoy a unique authentic experience watching a silent film. A light lunch is followed before we commence our homeward leg, arriving in Brisbane late afternoon with many happy memories after our **wonderful time away exploring Hervey Bay, Fraser Island and 1770 with The Donald Simpson Centre and Trade Travel.**
