Day 1. Mon 13 May: Brisbane - Echo Point - Portland - Bathurst Flight Details: Brisbane - Sydney (times to be advised)

We then continue to Bathurst where we visit the Chifley Home and Education Centre, the home of former Prime Minister Ben Chifley. We then continue to our accommodation at Rydges Mount Panorama for check-in and then gather for dinner in the Chicane Bar and Grill.

Day 2. Tues 14 May: Bathurst - Orange

After breakfast and checkout we take a drive around the iconic Mt Panorama Race Track passing Brock's Skyline before taking a look through The National Motor Racing Museum which celebrates the rich history of Australian Motor Sport. Next stop is the historic 1870's Abercrombie House for a guided tour and lunch. From there we head to Orange where we take in the stunning views from the Mt Lindsay Lookout, before check-in at our Hotel for our 2 night stay. After a freshen up, we gather in Diggers Bar and Grill for dinner.

This morning, we meet our local guide for an introduction tour of Orange starting at the heritage listed Cook Park and the Botanic Gardens with its impressive autumn display for all to enjoy. Through March and April, hundreds of begonias bloom in the 'Blowes Conservatory'. At the Guildry in 'Bastick Cottage', a Victorian style, heritage building we find a wide range of unique hand-crafted goods including pottery, knitting, woodwork, homemade jams and freshly baked goods. Next stop is at the **Orange Regional Museum**, where the collection and exhibitions tell stories about Orange and the region, its history, people and places. Down in the heritage listed village of **Millthorpe** we enjoy **lunch** at the Millthorpe Providore before calling into the Golden Memories Millthorpe Museum complex. On our return to Orange we visit the family run Lucknow Skin Shop and Boot Barn before arriving back at our accommodation with time to freshen up before dinner back in the on-site bar and restaurant.

Day 4. Thurs 16 May: Orange - Dubbo - Sunset Safari

Our adventure continues today as we travel towards Dubbo via Wellington, with a stop at the **Osawano Japanese** Gardens. These gardens are the result of a \$270,000 gift from Wellington's Japanese sister city - Osawano. After morning tea from the coach, we continue our drive into Dubbo where we tour the historic **Old Dubbo Gaol** which operated for 119 years from 1847 to 1966. This regional gaol is representative of powerful, surprising and dark moments in Australian prison history.

After our gaol experience we break for lunch (own purchase) before heading out to Western Plains Zoo to check into our unique Zoofari Lodge accommodation. Late afternoon, we take in a Sunset Safari Tour and giraffe feeding, followed by canapés and a banquet dinner and a relaxing after-dinner drink or cocktail around the camp fire. What a fantastic way to end the day!

Later in the afternoon we check into our accommodation with time to rest up before dinner.

We then continue back into Bathurst and check back in our accommodation where we enjoy a freshen up before our final night's dinner.
