Day 1. Mon 16 Feb: Brisbane - Richmond - Hobart

Dinner

Flight Details: VA0702 Brisbane - Hobart, 0940/1330 (flights are subject to change)

After our morning flight into Hobart we meet up with our local coach captain before making our way up the **historic township of Richmond**. We enjoy some free time to purchase some refreshments before **touring the notorious convict built Richmond Gaol, the oldest, still intact, gaol in Australia**. On our way into Hobart we enjoy a short **city highlights tour** before arriving at our hotel for check in, freshen up and dinner.

Overnight Hobart: The Old Woolstore Apartment Hotel

Day 2. Tues 17 Feb: Hobart

Breakfast

This morning we tour the World Heritage listed **Cascades Female Factory Historic Site** for a greater understanding and appreciation for the largely untold story of female convicts sent to Australia. Next stop is **Runnymede** a beautifully preserved **1840 whaling captain's house and gardens**. On our **Captain's House Tour** we discover everything this lovely homestead has to offer before taking a **leisurely stroll around the beautiful gardens**. For the remainder of the day the choice is ours, with a drop off and pick up offered for both the **Royal Tasmanian Botanical Gardens and Constitution Dock precinct**. On arrival at the gardens, pop into the Visitor Hub located at the main gate, grab a map and ask the staff about what highlights there are to explore across the 14 hectares of gardens. At the **Constitution Dock precinct** we have many options to visit, such as the **Maritime Museum of Tasmania, Mawson's Huts Replica Museum and Tasmania Museum and Art Gallery**. Please note all entry fees for this afternoon are at own cost. This evening is also at leisure with dinner at own cost and choice of venue.

Overnight Hobart: The Old Woolstore Apartment Hotel

Day 3. Wed 18 Feb: Bruny Island

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today after breakfast we travel by ferry across to **Bruny Island** to explore the beautiful scenery and sample the delicious gourmet produce made on the island. We will be engaging with local artisan producers from the island such as an oyster farmer, cheese maker, fudge maker and a whisky distiller to hear the stories behind their harvests. **Our Bruny Island experience** will include visits to; **Bruny Island Cheese Co** where we meet the cheese maker and share in a platter of their award-winning cheeses and hand crafted beer. We enjoy lunch at a **Seafood Restaurant in Adventure Bay** and also visit **Bruny Island Chocolate Factory**, home to handmade chocolate, fudge and truffles. At **Bruny Island Honey** we sample the highly prized Manuka honey and shop for all things honey! During the day we also enjoy short walks along deserted beaches and see white wallabies, native wildlife and birds in their natural habitat. At the end of our day on Bruny Island we board the ferry once more, returning to the mainland and our accommodation for a well-deserved rest before dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Overnight Hobart: The Old Woolstore Apartment Hotel

Day 4. Thurs 19 Feb: West Coast Wilderness Region - Strahan

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

We depart Hobart today for the great West Coast Wilderness Region. The **Salmon Ponds and Museum of Trout Fishing** is our first stop, taking a walk back in time amidst the historic buildings, hatchery and fish ponds – all set within the original 19th century English style public open space of superb trees, hedges and lawns. We then continue across to **Tarraleah Estate for a light lunch**. Tarraleah isn't just special place with stunning views of the Tasmanian Highlands and wilderness, it was once the home of hundreds of hydroelectric pioneers. We then head across towards Derwent Bridge, to the amazing **Wall in the Wilderness** - Greg Duncan's commemorative wooden carvings of those who helped shape the past and present of Tasmania's central highlands. Our journey then continues through the **Franklin Gordon Wild Rivers National Park** before the spectacular drive down to Queenstown, through the mountain summits, resembling a cratered moonscape - created by a brutal mining past.

Day 4. Continued

We then arrive into picturesque village of Strahan, located on Australia's 2nd largest Harbour, Macquarie Harbour, Strahan is the gateway to the Franklin-Gordon World Heritage area. After check-in, take advantage of the twilight and take photos of this pretty village, then gather in View 42 for a **delicious buffet dinner**.

Overnight Strahan: Strahan Village

Day 5. Fri 20 Feb: Wilderness Lunch Cruise - The Ship That Never Was

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning after breakfast, we take a stroll down to the wharf to board **World Heritage Cruises** for a delightful half day **lunch cruise**, taking us out across **Macquarie Harbour**, and down along the **Gordon River**. Cruise highlights include Hells Gates, Salmon farms, guided Sarah Island stop-over, Gordon River heritage landing board walk and Huon Pine Sawmill. Enjoy lunch featuring delicious Tasmanian produce and listen to the skippers live commentary, which brings the river and its rich history to life, all providing an unforgettable experience on the Gordon River. Following our cruise we enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at leisure, explore the delightful village at own pace, visit the West Coast Information Centre, stroll the Historic Foreshore Walk or call into **Morrison's Huon Pine Sawmill**. Before dinner this evening, we enjoy a special treat as we witness "**The Ship That Never Was**", which tells the dramatic and hilarious true story of the Great Escape from Sarah Island! Following the show we enjoy dinner back at the Village.

Overnight Strahan: Strahan Village

Day 6. Sat 21 Feb: Cradle Mountain

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast and checkout we begin our drive up to the Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park, travelling through the historic mining township of Zeehan, then through Rosebery and Tullah, before arriving at the **Cradle Mountain Visitors Centre**, where our **Park Explorer** awaits. From the Cradle Mountain Visitors Centre we travel into the world class national park and take in amazing sights and highlights such as **Dove Lake** and the **historic Boat Shed**, spectacular and iconic views of **Cradle Mountain** plus a visit to **Waldhelm Chalet** and a couple of delightful short walks. After our tour we enjoy a light **lunch at the Cradle Mountain Hotel**, followed by the **Devils at Cradle "Daykeepers Tour"**. The sanctuary houses a large number of adult, sub-adult and baby devils within a range of naturally landscaped viewing enclosures. This afternoon we depart Cradle Mountain National Park and begin our drive to Smithton for check in at our Tall Timbers accommodation. After settling into our rooms we gather on-site for dinner.

Overnight Smithton: Tall Timbers

Day 7. Sun 22 Feb: North West Coast Touring - Arthur River

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today we travel across to the small settlement of Arthur River on the rugged North West Coast. We then join our **Arthur River Cruise** on-board the **MV George Robinson**, experiencing one of the last truly "wild rivers" in this unforgettable wilderness. Be spellbound by the magical reflections of the lush vegetation in the tannin coloured river. Take in the pristine densely forested river banks of myrtles, blackwoods, leatherwoods, sassafras, silver wattles and endangered Brooker's gums. At **Turk's Landing** we enjoy a **BBQ lunch** as we gaze up at the giant brown top stringybark (Tassie Oak) and marvel at the ancient giant tree ferns. Our cruise includes a white breasted sea eagle feeding, viewing of their 50 year old nest site, extensive commentary and a guided forest walk with our skipper. This afternoon we take a short drive to the '**Edge of the World**' and breath in the cleanest air in the world. After a beautiful day exploring the World Heritage Tarkine region of Tasmania we head back to our accommodation for a relaxing evening and dinner.

Overnight Smithton: Tall Timbers

Day 8. Mon 23 Feb: Stanley - Table Cape - Launceston

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast and checkout we head up to **Stanley**, a town of perfectly preserved colonial buildings nestled at the foot of a volcanic core called the "**Nut**." On arrival we tour the **Highfield Historic Site**, taking a walk through the old homestead, outbuildings and surrounding gardens. Next, we delight in visiting the magnificent plateau of **Table Cape**, by far Wynyard's most remarkable natural wonder. Sitting at 180metres high, 'The Cape' - as locals refer to it - dominates the Wynyard coastline and offers spectacular photo opportunities and views from the of Tasmania's coast and agricultural farmlands. From late September and through October we are able to take in spectacular '**Tulip Fields**'. Our next experience is at **Hellyers Road Distillery** for **lunch** and fully **interpreted tour of the distillery 'The famous Whisky Walk'**, then an opportunity to pour, wax and seal our very own bottle of our limited edition Hellyers Road Distiller's Choice whisky. Our last stop for the day is at the **House of Anvers Chocolate Shop**, enjoy free samples as we browse the product range. We arrive down in Launceston later in the afternoon for check in and dinner.

Overnight Launceston: Hotel Grand Chancellor Launceston

Day 9. Tues 24 Feb: Launceston

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

We start our day in Launceston with a **highlights drive** around the lovely parks and gardens, before embarking on a 50 minute **Cataract Gorge cruise**, exploring the old and new facets of the Launceston Seaport precinct of today. We then head across to Longford, home to the World Heritage listed **Brickendon Estate** to spend some time with Louise Archer who provides a rare insight into the early colonial and convict history of Australia. Explore the convict buildings of the farm village and also the gardens with some of the oldest trees in Australia to the most scented old fashioned roses, shrubberies, walks and planted beds. Following our **tour and lunch** our next stop is at the **Tasmanian Gourmet Sauce Company**, where we will be guided through **complimentary tastings** and recipes, witness all the action in the **kitchen** including '**Big Bertha**' and enjoy a self-guided **garden tour**. We then head back to our motel to relax before meeting up for dinner at the hotel.

Overnight Launceston: Hotel Grand Chancellor Launceston

Day 10. Wed 25 Feb: Tamar Valley - Evandale - St Helens

Breakfast & Dinner

Today we experience the scenic **Tamar Valley and Beauty Point** before heading across to the **scenic east coast**. Up at Beauty Point we visit **Platypus House** for a rare chance to see and learn about the unique Tasmanian platypus and echidna.

Day 10. Continued

Next stop is **Seahorse World** which offers an insight into the mystical and elegant seahorse at various stages of development, along with the leafy sea dragon and the pipefish. After our tour we enjoy **a cuppa and slice** in the **Cormorant Cafe** before travelling across the Batman Bridge for our journey to the East Coast. After stopping by the **Legerwood Memorial Tree Carvings** in **Scottsdale**, we continue through to the **Pyengana Farmgate Café**, home of the Pyengana story. Hear of the farmers of Pyengana that have been handcrafting traditional cloth-matured farmhouse cheddar for over 130 years, with traditional recipes using heritage vats that have passed through generations of Pyengana artisans. Late afternoon we arrive in St Helens for check in and dinner.

Overnight St Helens: The Panorama Hotel

Day 11. Thurs 26 Feb: Freycinet Peninsula - Hobart

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today after check out we head down through Coles Bay to the magnificent **Freycinet Peninsula**, home to **Cape Tourville** which offers spectacular and rugged coastal views from the easily accessible boardwalk. The elevated track loops around the **automated lighthouse** and at times taking us right to the cliff edge, offering amazing views of the **Hazards**, **Wineglass Bay** and nearby offshore rocks known as **The Nuggets**. We then travel down to **Swansea** for lunch at **The Saltshaker**, before travelling back down into Hobart for check-in and a bit of leisure time before dinner.

Overnight Hobart: The Old Woolstore Apartment Hotel

Day 12 Fri 27 Feb: Peppermint Bay Cruise

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning after breakfast we head around to the **Mount Nelson Signal Station Lookout** and take in the panoramic views over Hobart city, the River Derwent and, on a clear day, down to Bruny Island and out to Storm Bay. We then step aboard our **Peppermint Bay Cruise** which provides a great way to experience the city's harbour, beachside towns and wildlife on route to the Peppermint Bay Hotel. Arriving at Peppermint Bay a short stroll takes us to the restaurant to enjoy the chef's special set menu based on seasonal produce from the garden and of course local producers, whilst we soak up the views over the d'Entrecasteaux Channel and Bruny Island. Later in the day we arrive back at Sullivan's Cove and then transfer back to our accommodation to rest up before our farewell dinner.

Day 13. Sat 28 Feb: Salamanca Markets - Hobart - Homeport

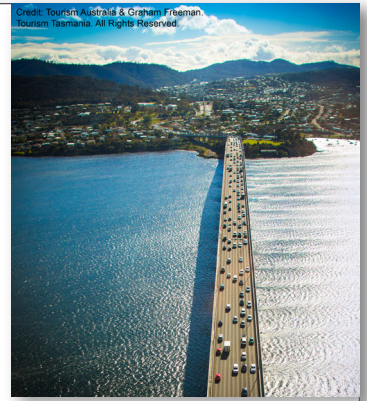
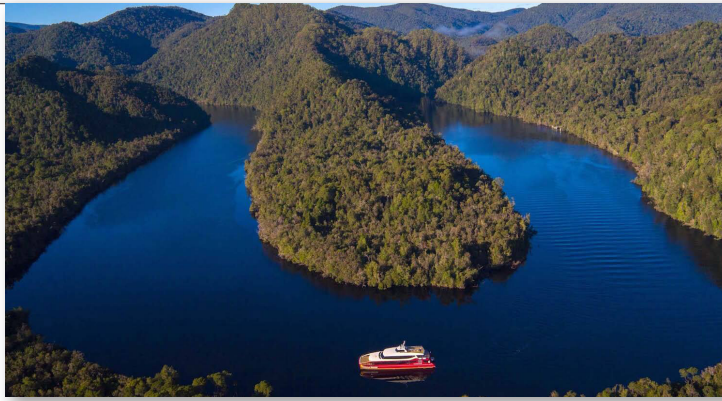
