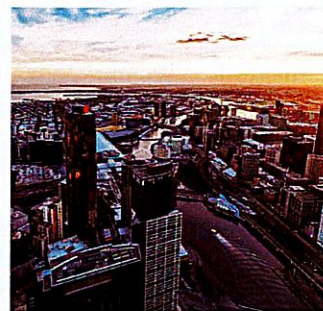
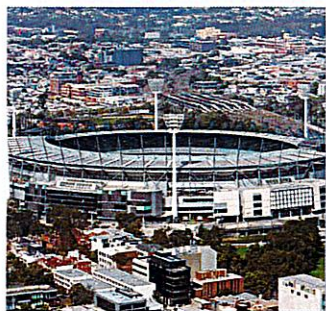

Day 1. Sat 22 Nov: Brisbane - Melbourne - MCG

Lunch & Dinner

Flight details: VA314 Brisbane - Melbourne 0755/1115

This morning we arrive at Brisbane Airport for our flight into Melbourne, where on arrival we board our coach and make way into Melbourne. Our first stop is at the **iconic MCG for lunch** in the **Trumble Bar and Cafe** followed by a tour of the **Australian Sports Museum**, home to Australia's largest collection of sporting memorabilia. Then we **explore the inner sanctum of the MCG**, walk on the hallowed turf and experience where legends play before going behind the scenes visiting the famous **Long Room** and other iconic areas. Later in the afternoon we check into our well located city accommodation with time to freshen up before meeting for drinks (own cost) and dinner at the hotel.

Day 2. Sun 23 Nov: Q Train 'First Class' - Eureka Tower Skydeck

Breakfast & Lunch

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before we transfer down to the Bellarine Peninsula's **Drysdale Railway Station**. On arrival we enjoy a **welcome drink** before **joining Geelong's famous Q Train** for our 11.30am, **'First Class' rail journey along the Bellarine Peninsula** between the Drysdale and Queenscliff stations. Enjoy the best produce from Geelong, Bellarine and the Otway's, incorporated into our **delicious 5 course degustation menu with unique 'Drink Paring' for each course**. Once we arrive back at the station approximately 3 hours later we board our coach and travel back to Melbourne and have a stop at the **highest observation deck in the Southern Hemisphere**, the **Eureka Tower Skydeck** to witness amazing views across the city and beyond. We then return back to the hotel for an afternoon and evening at our own leisure for dinner.

Day 3. Mon 24 Nov: Rippon Lea Estate - Melbourne Holocaust Museum

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After a relaxing morning, we head to **Rippon Lea Estate** to tour the **magnificent mansion** followed by an insightful 45 minute social history tour of the garden led by a national trust guide. Discover the captivating stories about the mansion's history and the remarkable individuals who shaped it. Then explore the **heritage gardens**, featuring beautiful trees, expansive lawns, and the largest fernery in the Southern Hemisphere. Following our tour we can purchase a cuppa from the cafe to enjoy with our **picnic lunch packs within the beautiful gardens**. This afternoon we visit the **Melbourne Holocaust Museum**, where with our **guide** we walk through history with the permanent exhibitions featuring testimonies, artefacts, photographs and documents from the Melbourne survivor community. After leaving the museum we return back to the hotel for some leisure or shopping time. We regather in the hotel tonight for dinner.

Day 4. Tues 25 Nov: Dandenong's - Puffing Billy

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning we depart for the foothills of the Dandenong's, arriving at the Puffing Billy Railway Station in Belgrave. We **board the Puffing Billy** for a ride on Australia's oldest surviving and most famous preserved steam train. Our sentimental journey takes us through the countryside, showing the lush mountain scenery with its amazing panoramic views before arriving at the **Emerald Lake Park Reserve**. Back on our coach we travel up through Monbulk for **lunch at Sky High**, one of Victoria's premier attractions with the most stunning views. Stroll through the beautiful landscaped gardens, take a forest walk under a canopy of Australian eucalyptus, visit the Australian Tree, or relax on the Giant's Chair. Our last stop for the day is in the pretty **village of Sassafras** which completes our delightful day in the Dandenong's before travelling back across Melbourne to our hotel to relax before dinner.

Day 5. Wed 26 Nov: Mount Macedon

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Another delightful day awaits as we travel up to Mount Macedon, home to the **Mount Macedon Memorial Cross**, an imposing structure that commemorates all those who served in wars and conflicts. Spectacular views south and back towards Melbourne can be enjoyed at several locations before visiting the **Stokes Collection and Forest Glade Gardens**. The remarkable Stokes Collection represents a life-long passion of Cyril Stokes, bearing witness to his love and knowledge of beautiful decorative arts. After our guided tour of the collection we are free to explore one of the most beautiful gardens in Australia.

Day 5. cont... From Forest Glade we make our way past the **mysterious Hanging Rock** before arriving at **Hanging Rock** which is set in a **breathtakingly beautiful location**. On arrival we enjoy **tastings** and special **local produce platters** featuring a selection of local artisan cheeses and cured, estate-grown beef, served with a range of seasonal accompaniments. Mid afternoon we return back to our Melbourne hotel to relax before our farewell dinner.

Breakfast & Lunch

After breakfast and checkout this morning, we are in for one last treat as we travel out to **Living Legends**, home to some of the retired legends of the turf. We are able to rub shoulders with some of these equine royals such as **Apache Cat, Santa Ana Lane** and of course **Prince of Penzance, whom Michelle Payne rode to that famous victory in the 2015 Melbourne Cup**, and in doing so becoming the first ever female jockey to win the cup. During our visit we also get to take a stroll around the **Woodlands Homestead** and enjoy some refreshments within the **heritage gardens**. Its then time to head across to the Melbourne Airport to checkin for our flight back to Brisbane after our amazing short break away in greater Melbourne with **Trade Travel**.
