

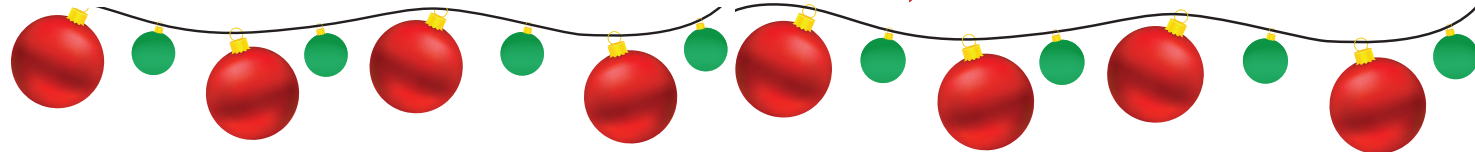

We cover most of the Island and learn what it was like in the first settlement, penal times in Norfolk Island and the arrival of the Pitcairn Islanders, descendants of the famous Mutiny on the Bounty. Visit Kingston, Cascade, Anson Bay and the wonderful St Barnabas Chapel. We top off our morning at the amazing **Cyclorama**, a multi award winning Norfolk Island attraction. Cyclorama is an amazing 360 degree mural that vividly illustrates the journey of the Bounty aboard the HMS Bounty from England to Tahiti to Pitcairn Island and Norfolk Island. An experience not to be missed!

### Dinner Hilli Restaurant

Tonight we enjoy a two-course dinner at the Hilli Restaurant. The word 'hilli' is a word from the unique Norfolk language which can be defined as a drowsy, lazy feeling... A feeling of lethargy.
