Day 1. Tue 27 Sep: Brisbane - Sydney

Flight Details: Brisbane - Sydney (times to be advised)

Lunch & Dinner

From our hotel rooms we enjoy stunning views of the magnificent Sydney Harbour and one of the most unforgettable cities. After time to freshen up we gather in **LB's Restaurant** for pre-dinner drinks at own cost before dinner.

Now we can hear them all in a spectacular new production that has stunned critics across the United Kingdom and North America. Day 3. Thu 29 Sep: Historic Parramatta Precinct - Q Station - Eye Tower Dinner Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning after breakfast we make our way into Circular Quay where **we board the 9.07am River Cat Ferry** for a delightful **cruise up the Parramatta River to Parramatta.** After passing under the famous Sydney Harbour Bridge and by the iconic Sydney Opera House, we call into several ports before arriving in Parramatta at 10.30am. Here we meet our local historian and author **Judith Dunn** for a guided tour in and around the historic sites of **Parramatta.** Following this we enjoy **lunch at Lachlan's Old Government House** before heading across to the iconic seaside beach haven of **Manly**, home to the **Q Station** where for over 150 years it was the beginning of a new life in Australia. Enjoy a one hour history overview of the station before returning to our hotel to enjoy a rest and freshen up before our **spectacular dining experience** at the renowned **Sydney Tower Restaurant.** Offering over 50 freshly-prepared dishes from a range of cuisines including modern Australian, Vietnamese, Chinese, Japanese, Italian and a selection of fresh seafood. Day 4. Fri 30 Sep: Queen Victoria Building - Sydney Harbour Lunch Cruise - Brisbane

Designed by George McRae and completed in 1898, the QVB replaced the original Sydney markets on the site. Built as a monument to the long reigning monarch, construction took place in dire times as Sydney was in a severe recession. The elaborate Romanesque architecture was specially planned for the grand building so the government could employ many out-of-work craftsmen - stonemasons, plasterers and stained window artists - in a worthwhile project. Originally, a concert hall, coffee shops, offices, showrooms, warehouses and a wide variety of tradespeople, such as tailors, mercers, hairdressers and florists, were accommodated. Before leaving we enjoy one last look at the beautiful harbour as we board our **lunch cruise of Sydney Harbour.** Following our cruise we transfer to the Sydney airport for check in and our return flights back to Brisbane after a wonderful time away on our Phantom of the Opera tour with Trade Travel.
